# Quickly Attach Skid Steer Style Attachments

In 1999 I was a local Bobcat Sales Specialist and had traded my customers 864F CTL in on a new 337 compact excavator. Everything was great until a week later when I got a desperate phone call from him asking "I've got a load of sod being delivered, how am I going to unload it"?

Quickly I located a used skid steer Bobtach® from a old junk skid steer loader and a new Xchange® excavator bracket and headed for the local welding shop. They welded the excavator bucket mount to the skid steer loader mount and the 1st **HookUP** was born.

I loaded it into my pick-up and stopped by his yard to get the pallet forks. Now his excavator became a forklift and the pallets of sod were unloaded and placed through-out the landscape job. The customer later used the HookUP with a big light material bucket, auger, trencher, grapple, and rock rake attachments.
